Center Support Staff report to the Director or Center Assistant. Center Support Staff provides the children with developmentally appropriate activities, provides a nurturing environment, and interacts with the children, their parents, staff members, and volunteers. Center Support Staff will actively supervise children to ensure safety in the classroom and on the playground.

The Center Support Staff are responsible for:

- o Room coverage at lunch and other times when necessary.
- o Maintain classroom control, management, and sanitation.
- o Provide a normal routine by maintaining daily schedule adherence.
- Must keep the Director and Center Assistant informed of situations concerning staff members, children, and parental issues.
- o Maintaining the Center's policies and procedures.
- o Attend on-going training.
- o Additional duties as needed.

Requirements are:

- o HS Diploma or equivalent
- o Completion of Parts I & II of the required DCF Child Care Training (or in progress)
- o Current background checks
- o Completion of 5-hour Birth-Age 3 Early Literacy course (or to be completed within 90 days of hire)
- O Current First Aid and CPR (or willing to obtain)
