



Infant Teacher

The Infant Teacher will be responsible for the care and education of infants in the classroom. In this position, the teacher will create a safe and nurturing environment for infants to learn and grow. The teacher will be expected to design and implement age-appropriate activities and curriculum to support their physical and emotional development.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- o Create and implement daily lesson plans that align with the developmental needs of infants.
- o Provide a safe and nurturing environment for infants to grow and learn.
- o Attend to the physical and emotional needs of infants, including feeding, diapering, and comforting.
- o Observe and document developmental progress of infants and communicate with parents/guardians daily through verbal and written communication.
- o Collaborate with other teachers and staff to ensure continuity of care and education
- o Maintain a clean and organized classroom by following proper diapering and sanitizing procedures.
- o Follow all state licensing regulations regarding infant care and education.
- o Participate in professional development opportunities to stay current with best practices in infant care and education.

The minimum qualifications for this position are:

- o HS Diploma or equivalent
- o Completion of Parts I & II of the required DCF Child Care Training
- o Current CDA & Staff Credential (required for Lead Infant Teacher)
- o Current background checks
- o Completion of any additional trainings as required by the Florida Department of Early Learning, the Early Learning Coalition, or Child Care Licensing
- o Current First Aid and CPR (or willing to obtain)
